Dallas Public Library to present unique view of the presidency

Authors will discuss a history of presidential dining and entertaining

Dallas, TX – A unique view of presidential campaigning, dining and diplomacy will be presented at the Dallas Public Library, 1515 Young St., at 7 p.m. Tuesday, Feb. 5. “Campaign Memorabilia” will feature 80 objects, some never before shown, from the extraordinary Presidential collections of historians **Jordan M. Wright**, author of *Campaigning for President* and **Barry H. Landau**, author of *The President's Table*.

Campaigning for President is the colorful story of how presidents (and their losing rivals) have wooed voters since America was founded, while *The President's Table* is a history of presidential entertaining from George Washington to George W. Bush.

A reception will be held from 6 to 7 p.m. in the 3rd floor Studio, followed by a discussion with the authors and a book signing on the first floor.
